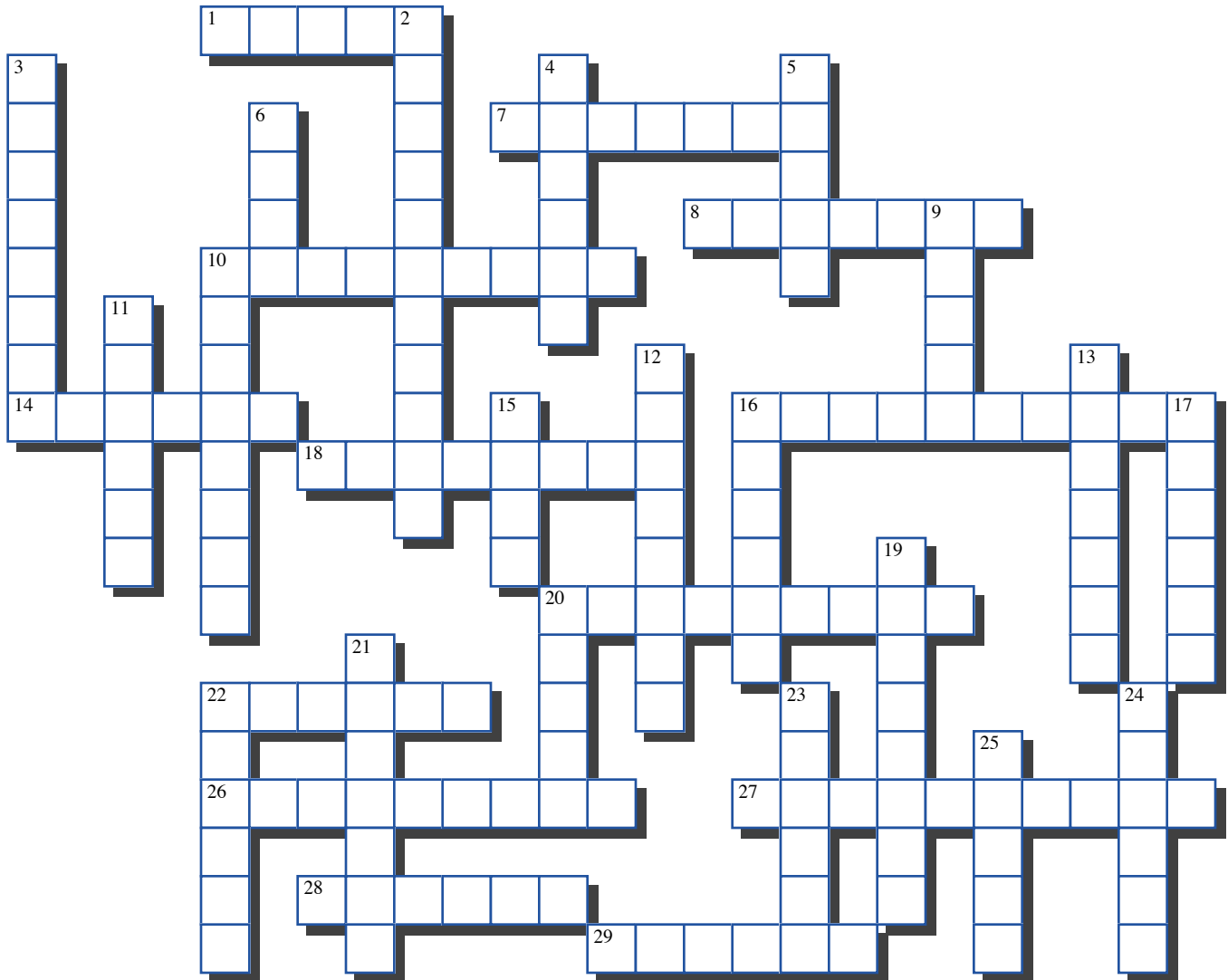


Neo-Pagan Crossword Puzzle

10. A five-pointed star drawn with a single line. (9)
14. One of the eight celebrations of paganism. (6)
16. Regular meeting place for a coven. Usually the home of the high priestess or high priest. (10)
18. A pentagram surrounded by a circle and carved on a circlet of wood or other natural object. (8)
20. Festival held on feb. 1. One of the 4 Celtic "fire festivals. (9)

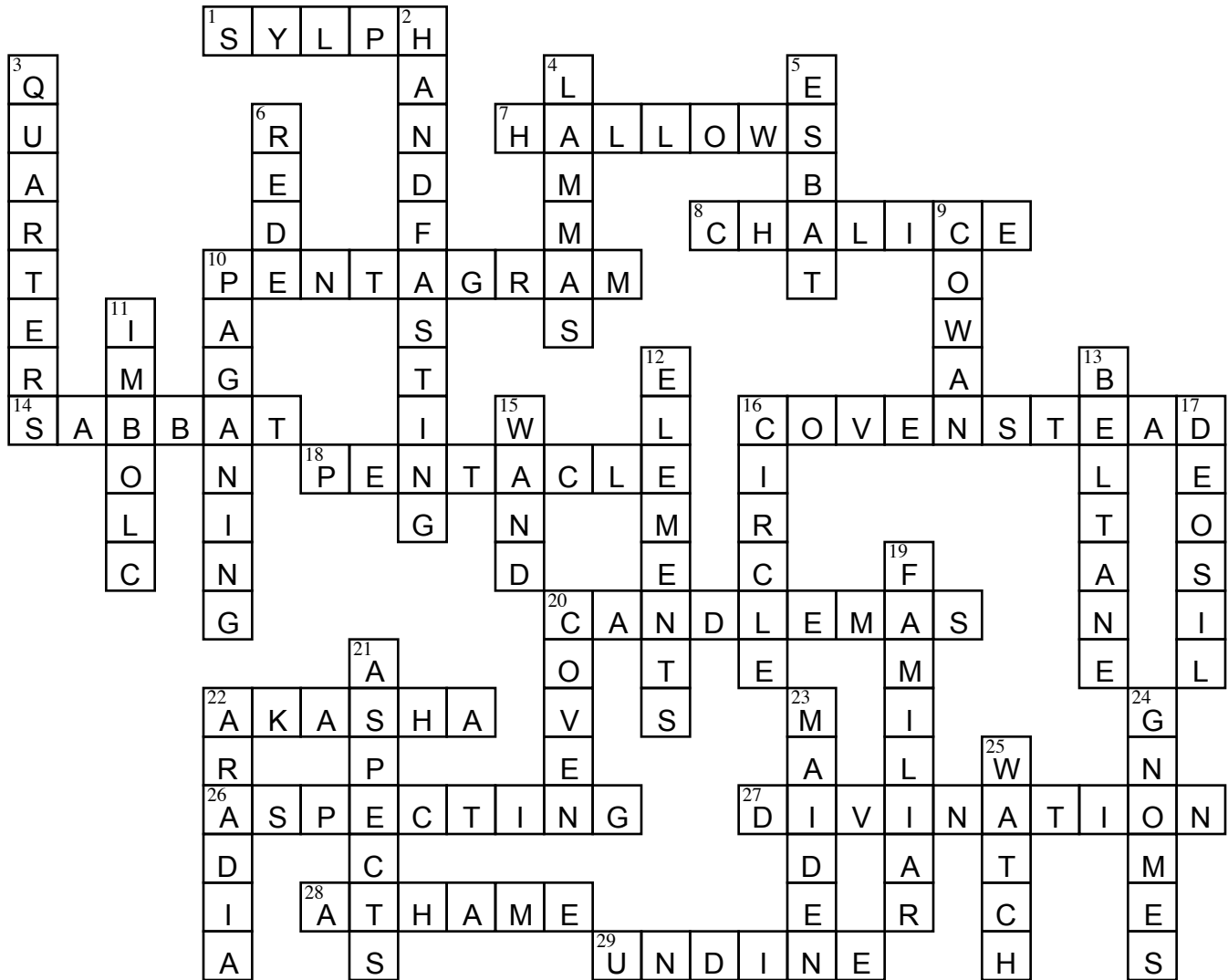
29. An "entity" or "elemental" that dwells in the plane of water or is associated with the water element. (6)

10. Presentation of an infant to the circle and to the gods. (8)
11. Celtic name for Candlemas. (6)
12. Earth, air, fire, and water, plus spirit, which includes them all. (8)
13. May eve festival. One of the ancient Celtic "fire festivals." (7)
15. A rod or staff that is prepared so that it may be used for magickal or psychic purposes. (4)
16. The sacred space where in all magick is to be worked and all ritual contained. (6)
17. Clockwise movement for rituals and ceremonies and spells. (6)
19. A spirit or guardian who is close to a human being and considered a companion in magick. (8)
20. A group of witches who worship and work together. (5)

22. Italian goddess sworn to protect her people against aggression of masculine faith and its persecutors. (6)
